

## **POLICY ON DINGHY SPACE RENTAL**

RPEYC members will be able to rent space for authorised craft such as dinghies, small sail craft and paddle craft. Sailboards are not encouraged. The terms and conditions for such rentals are detailed below. Should any of these conditions be broken, the Committee has the right to cancel the rental - without refund - and remove the craft housed in the space.

- While the member is regarded as renting the space and can place any authorised type of vessel in the rack, the Committee reserves the right to request the removal of any craft it deems unsuitable.
- The member may continue to be charged rental even if the space is vacant, if they have not advised the Committee in writing that they no longer wish to continue renting the space.
- Stored craft are to be in good condition and are to be free of sand and in clean condition when stored.
- The member renting the space must substantially own the craft in the rented space. Boats not owned by the renting member can be removed by the Committee and the rental agreement terminated without refund.
- All craft, spars, etc shall be clearly marked with the owner's name or hull number in the event of registered craft.
- Craft on bottom racks are to be kept on trolleys to facilitate movement for cleaning of storage areas. Trolleys are at the lessee's cost.
- Rental payments will be for six months in advance. Payments are to be made within 30 days' notice. Late payment may result in cessation of the rental agreement and removal of whatever craft is in the space.
- There will be no refund should a member terminate a rental agreement within the six-month rental period.
- Should the demand for rental spaces exceed supply the Committee will allocate spaces on the basis of usage. Thus the Committee reserves the right to cancel the rental agreement at the expiration of any six-month period due to lack of use of the craft housed in the space.
- Only gear used in the operation of the craft may be stored in the craft.
- Only one craft shall be stored in the rental space at a time, unless otherwise agreed to by the Committee at the time of commencement of the rental agreement.
- The RPEYC does not accept responsibility for any damages incurred by boats on moorings under the Club's control; or to any items stored in racks or lockers. Insurance is the responsibility of the owner.
- The storage of the following chemicals in lockers or the boatshed is not permitted:
  - Flammable liquids
  - Corrosive substances (such as acids)
  - Toxic substances
  - Oxidising substances
  - Organic peroxides
