Case Introduction: Protest by The Holy Gale against Tiarnie involving Boat against Boat incident at leeward mark (N2), Not providing Mark room resulting in contact between boats.

#### **Procedural Matters:**

- 1. Protest Committee members declared that they had no conflicts of interest and no party objected to the members hearing the protest. In accordance with RRS 63.4
- 2. The requirements of RRS 61.1(a) & 61.1(a) (1) were met in that a red flag was displayed at the first opportunity and the notice of protest was lodged within the time limit specified in the Sailing Instructions

#### Facts found:

- 1. The wind was from the North East with a wind strength of approximately 10-15 knots
- 2. Both boats were sailing on a port reach towards the leeward mark N2.
- 3. Tiarnie was windward of The Holy Gale
- 4. Tiarnie entered the mark zone overlapped to windward of the Holy Gale
- 5. Tiarnie's headsail came into contact with the Holy Gale, no damage or injury occurred
- 6. Neither boat undertook penalty turns

#### Conclusion & Rules:

- 1. Tiarnie was overlapped and to Winward of The Holy Gale on entering the mark zone.
- 2. The Holy Gale was required to give mark room to Tiarnie
- 3. Tiarnie is exonerated for breaching Rule 14 through Rule 43.3

Rules applicable are RRS 18.2(b) & RRS 43.3

### Decision:

The protest is dismissed.
